Each document carefully detailed the requirements and codes used to report each measure. **PLEASE be sure to read each one carefully**, even if you reported on a particular quality measure in past years as **some of the measures have significant changes – particularly Measure 141, and Measure 226.** Both of these measures have reporting code changes and other changes to requirement.

### **Codes for E&M 99000 codes use reporting only (cannot be reported when coding 92000 code set**

**Quality ID #1 (CBE 0059):** Diabetes: Hemoglobin A1c (HbA1c) Poor Control (>9%) High Priority, Intermediate Outcome

**Quality ID #155 (CBE 0101):** Falls: Plan of Care (7 points total available) High Priority

**Quality ID #236:** Controlling High Blood Pressure High Priority Intermediate Outcome

### **Codes for either 92000 or 99000 code use reporting**

**Quality ID #141:** Primary Open-Angle Glaucoma (POAG): Reduction of Intraocular Pressure (IOP) by 20% OR Documentation of a Plan of Care High Priority Outcome

**Quality ID #181:** Elder Maltreatment Screen and Follow-Up Plan High Priority

**Quality ID #226 (CBE 0028):** Preventive Care and Screening: Tobacco Use: Screening and Cessation Intervention

**Quality ID #317:** Preventive Care and Screening: Screening for High Blood Pressure and Follow-Up Documented (7 points total available)
